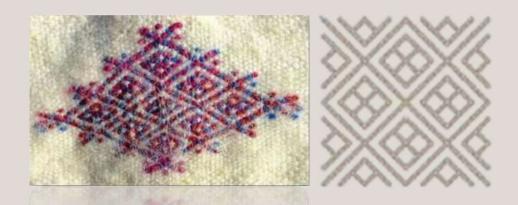

The Authority's logo is a story that summarizes Libya's history across civilizations, from the past to the present, to create the future.

The shape of the Authority's logo was derived from the types and shapes of decorative marks used as a fingerprint and mark that indicates its weaver in the Libyan regions, especially in weaving (the jird, the hawli, or the urdi) for both men and women, as weaving is considered one of the oldest professions and family projects that have been practiced within Libyan families since ancient times, and (the jird, the hawli, or the urdi) is considered a historical symbol of Libya since ancient times.

The Fasato region in the Nafusa Mountains is considered one of the most famous places for decorating woolen fabrics in the style known as raqma (decorative elements that adorn the edges of the rugs, hawli or urda), which has several different names:

The patterns of the engravings differ from one region to another, as each region has a special and distinctive character, i.e. a special engraving. By simply looking at the edges of the cloak, a person can distinguish the owner of the engraving or engraving and recognize his region.

· Main objective:

- Compiling a database of productive families and targeted projects to establish a mechanism for providing consultations and expertise to the Authority to evaluate and redirect projects, which achieves economic integration and provides integrated and harmonious productive families that work within a unified framework and vision and opens horizons for future projects and target markets.
- Providing a real, integrated database for the entities working to support projects related to the productive family (local or international), which ensures a clear vision of the work mechanism for the targeted projects and the possibility of following up on productive projects, while providing guarantees to project financiers and providing expertise to the productive family.
- Organization of exhibitions and supporting the participation of productive families in local and international exhibitions to open markets for them.
- Providing the requirements to support the production process for productive family projects.
- The primary role of the Authority is to mediate between productive families and supporters of their productive projects, such as the government and its related institutions, banks, and local and international organizations.



Establishment decision

Founding Resolution:

• Issuance of Prime Ministerial Resolution No. (834) of 2022 AD to establish an Authority to Encourage Productive Families.

Motives for creation:

• Improving the standard of living of families, increasing local production by diversifying sources of income for citizens in particular and the state in general, and enhancing competition in the local and international markets.

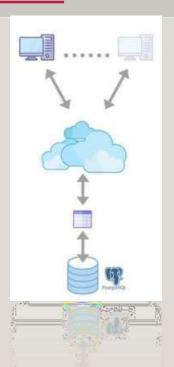
- **Exhibitions and trade fairs:** Providing opportunities for families to showcase their products and build relationships with potential buyers and partners.

Building a database

- Modern electronic platform: Entering data on productive families through a highly efficient platform.
- **Description of the electronic portal:** An electronic portal has been designed and developed to list and manage productive families, so that... The user can register and access his content, inquire, fill out and modify data in the forms according to the powers granted to him. Likewise, employees and officials of the Authority can manage and edit the data entered by users, according to work requirements.
- Classification of activities: Linking letters and activities to productive families to facilitate tracking work and support. User interface (window), which is an interface designed to register new productive families, as well as to enter families that have previously registered, and in which it is possible to fill out forms, review them, or inquire about services through the portal.





Create a platform to register families

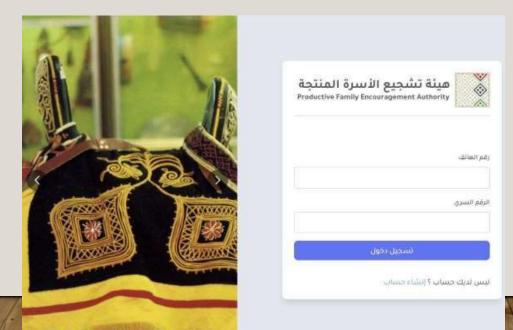
- Create a digital platform: A digital platform has been created to collect and record data on productive families wishing to register with the Authority.
- Integrated and reliable data: The platform relies on registering data after verifying the citizenship of the registrants by obtaining their personal data. APIs from relevant institutions and bodies and completing the rest of the data after verifying its accuracy.





Create a platform to register families

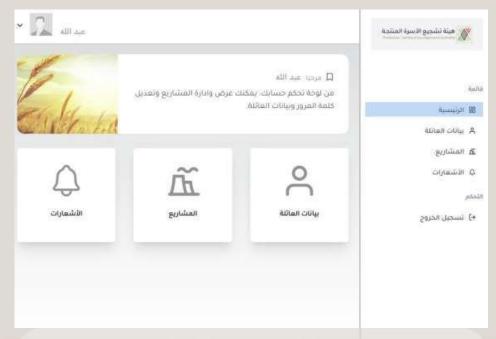
• Reliability and safety: A hierarchical method has been adopted for creating fields for inserting and completing data on the platform, in accordance with the best methods for organizing data on the platform allows the creation of a complete and clear database for registrants and facilitates the process of following up on procedures from system operators and families registered on the platform to improve the final procedures while taking into account providing the highest levels of security and privacy for registrants.





Create a platform to register families

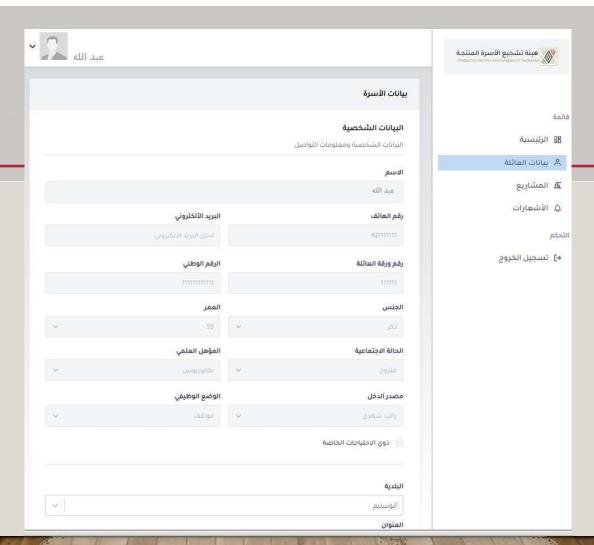
- **Home**:Contains the subscriber's name and the main categories that It is of interest to those registered on the platform.

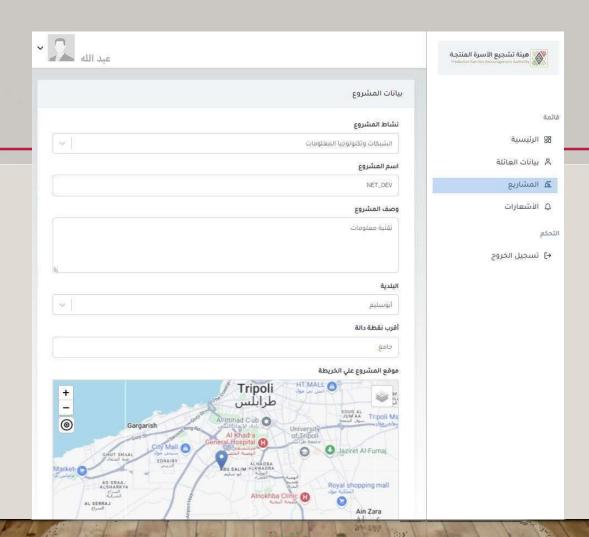

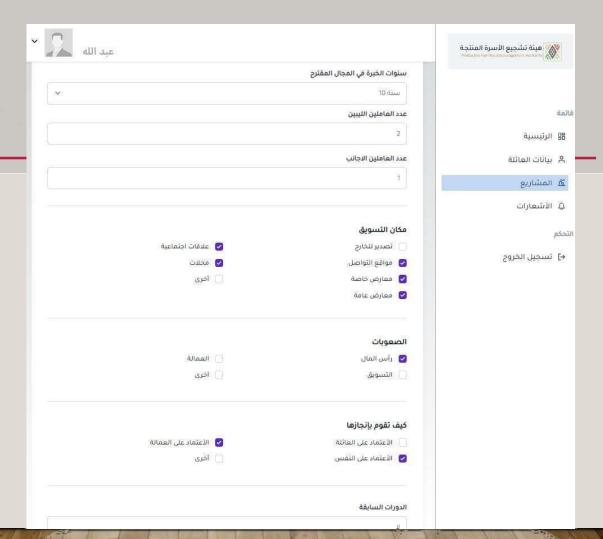

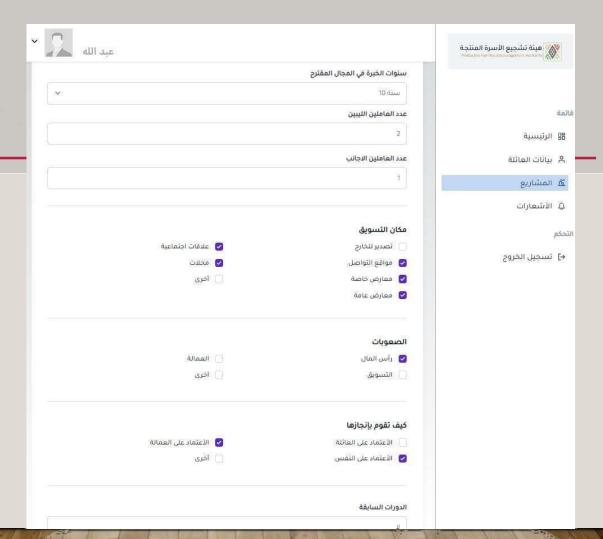

Interactive Dashboard

- View statistics and reports: Using an Interactive information board to display and analyze input data.
- Instant Reports: Enable management to access detailed reports at any time.







Follow-up and notification mechanism

- **Notification system:** Follow-up on the measures taken through: Notification system for productive families.
- Geographic search system: Possibility of searching for productive

Families nearby using the platform's geographic map. Locations can also be narrowed down according to activities to create a database for future planning of projects and managing them as integrated projects.







Mechanism of action

- Track work: Starting from registering productive families to providing support and marketing interface for employees and managers of the system. It is an interface designed to process and audit the data entered by families, as well as extract reports and indicators that can be used for many purposes. Some screens or Dashboards can be used to prepare visual or graphic reports.
- Recording training operations: Entering, documenting and reporting on vocational and technical training processes.
- Register for financial and technical support: Documenting all support operations and issuing periodic reports.
